EmERGE, a project funded by the European Union's Horizon 2020 Research and innovation Programme, is developing a new app based system to enable self-management of HIV in patients with stable disease.

This could involve fewer visits to the local clinic, and more personal access to results of your current health status – such as CD4 count and viral load. The data will be securely stored via your local clinic and accessed only by you via your mobile phone.

The HIV clinic Antwerp is looking to recruit people living with HIV to take part in a new trial which looks at using mobile phone applications – apps – to complement the way you access health care.
